

**RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS**  
**FORT LUPTON ART IN PUBLIC PLACES COMMITTEE**  
**Regular Meeting**  
**Thursday, May 17, 2018**

The Fort Lupton Art in Public Places Committee met at City Hall on Thursday, April 26, 2018. Chairperson Teri Kopfman called the meeting to order at 9:03 a.m.

**ROLL CALL**

Roll call was taken and those present were Teri Kopfman, Ysabel Molina, Kristel Acre and Carol Ruckel. Also in attendance were City Clerk Mari Pena and Buildings/Grounds/Forestry Manager Stacy Robinson .

**APPROVAL OF AGENDA**

It was moved by Ms Ruckel and seconded by Ms Acre that the Agenda be approved as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

**APPROVAL OF CONSENT AGENDA**

Approval of Minutes of April 26, 2018.

It was moved by Ms Acre and seconded by Ms Ruckel that the Consent Agenda be approved as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

**PUBLIC AND VISITOR INPUT**

There was no one present for public/visitor input.

**DISCUSSION ITEMS**

**a. Mission/Guidelines**

Ms Ruckel's latest draft was reviewed. Ms Pena suggested adding a definition of public art (including functional art). Ms Ruckel will do so and re-circulate the document for the next meeting.

**b. Horse with No Name**

Entries were reviewed from all but two of the boxes. Those two will be added to the pool at a special meeting Friday, May 18 at 2:30 p.m. at Wendy's. The top entries from this group were: iron Will, Links, Metallium (Latin), Pegamento de Metal, and Tin Cup with Bucephalus getting a nod for historical creativity.

**c. Tree Carving Update**

No update. Ms Pena and Mr. Robinson will calculate a cost for the preliminary budget. Mr. Robinson has a list of carvers.

**d. 4<sup>th</sup> of July Hand Painting/Skate Park**

Ms Pena will ask Council for permission for this project. Murals were discussed, with an emphasis on making them positive, as in the examples Ms Molina provided earlier.

**e. Chalk Art Project**

This project has been approved, to take place on the west side of Koshio Park as part of National Night Out activities on August 7. We will put up our Art in Public Places sign, with committee members encouraged to be in attendance.

**f. Project Dedication Markers**

Ms Kopfman provided pictures of examples of plaques; metal is preferred as it lasts the longest. Estimated cost is \$300+ for plaque plus \$200 for rock. Ms Kopfman and Ms Ruckel will try to get this donated by Forlorado Club.

**g. Update on Downtown Fort Lupton**

Ms Acre reported that the first Firepit Friday will be June 22 from 5-8 p.m. Participants will visit businesses to obtain ingredients for s'mores, to be roasted at 4<sup>th</sup> and Denver Ave. The city's pop-up park will be installed in the Bank of Colorado parking lot there.

**i. Other Updates**

Ms Acre will nudge John Newton to repair his metal flowers. Ms Molina has a contact with a regional manager at Burger King for possible future donations.
